





HGV and Specialist Vehicles Procurement Framework Including Contract Hire of HGVs and Buses

Agreement Reference: NEPO224

The Framework Agreement will run for 48 months until November 2021

The framework provides access to 54 suppliers (a mix of OE manufacturers, specialist vehicle convertors and contract hire providers).

The Procurement Partnership Ltd (TPPL) has completed a tendering exercise in partnership with The North East Procurement Organisation (NEPO) for a Procurement and Contract Hire Framework covering the following Lots:

- Lot 1: OEM Chassis 12.5t 44t including spare parts and maintenance contracts
- Lot 2: Vehicle Conversions up to 44t including spare parts and maintenance contracts
- Lot 3: Contract Hire of Heavy Goods Vehicles, 12.5t and above
- Lot 4: Contract Hire of Buses, 5 75 seats

Mini Competitions:

Participants will need to undertake a mini-competition exercise inviting quotations from suppliers from the relevant Lot(s). All mini-competitions under this Framework Agreement must be conducted by TPPL using the Delta e-sourcing portal or via the participants' own electronic portal. The suppliers for each Lot are detailed on the page overleaf. TPPL have set up the Framework Agreement and all suppliers on the portal, enabling the quick and efficient turnaround of mini-competitions on our members' behalf. If members intend to use their own portal please contact TPPL for the suppliers' contact details. Please note that where you are securing quotations for chassis from OE Manufacturers via Lot 1, you may specify any Vehicle Converter, where you are securing quotations from Vehicle Converters via Lot 2 you may specify any OE Manufacturer chassis.

Suppliers on the Framework (details below in ranked order)

Lot 1: Vehicle Chassis 12.5t – 44t

Including spare parts and maintenance contracts. Chassis supplied to be both converted and unconverted operating on Petrol, Diesel, Hybrid, Electric, LPG (liquid petroleum gas), Hydrogen and Bio fuels. This Lot is for the purchase of either unconverted chassis or converted chassis from the Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM), who can supply direct, or via any of their franchise dealerships.

Chassis to be supplied under this Lot include day and sleeper cabs of various wheelbases that are acceptable for conversion with body types including but not limited to: tippers, dropside, flat, beavertail, curtain-side, box, Luton, refuse collection, bin lifts and recycling bodies, gritter, snowplough and auger spreaders, tanker, gully emptier, aerial platforms, hook loader and demountable body systems, jetter, cranes, mobile library and offices, vehicle and plant recovery, street lighting and highway maintenance bodies, and any other body type a participant may require. The Lot will also include the options to offer spare parts and maintenance contract services.

If a converted vehicle is required under this Lot, the convertor may either be nominated by the participant or the OEM will use their preferred convertor. For clarity, purchases from this Lot will be made from OEMs of chassis (unconverted/ converted) that have been appointed to the framework in this Lot.

Lot 2: Vehicle Conversions up to 44t.

This Lot is for the purchase of converted chassis from the convertors appointed to the framework. Particpants can if they choose to, nominate a preferred chassis for conversion. Alternatively, where the participant owns an existing chassis, they can pay for the body only for the purpose of mounting on an existing chassis. Convertors can make available for sale ex-demonstration vehicles to participants within this Lot.

Body type conversions to include but not limited to: tippers, dropside, flat, beavertail, curtain-side, box, Luton, refuse collection, bin lifts and recycling bodies, gritter, snowplough and auger spreaders, tanker, gully emptier, aerial platforms, hook loader and demountable body systems, jetter, cranes, mobile library and offices, vehicle and plant recovery, street lighting and highway maintenance bodies, and any other body type a participant may require. The Lot will also include the options to offer spare parts and maintenance contract services.
